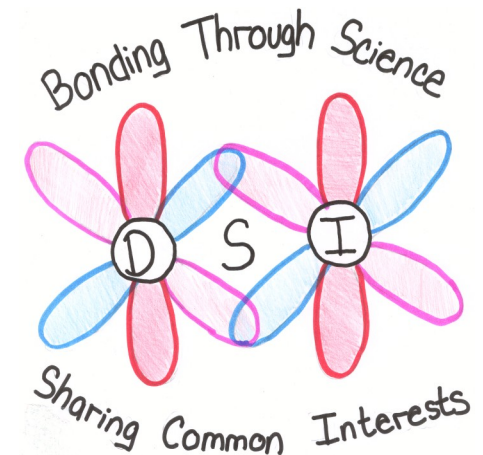

Once we arrive in D.C., we will head straight to the Westin Alexandria Hotel to check in. After check-in, you will be given instructions for the DSI Logo Activity.

After a great night's rest, we will board the bus at 9:15 a.m. to the **National Zoological Park** for a morning of exploring that will include the Amazonia Tropical Forest, Fuji-Film's Giant Panda Habitat and the Great Ape House, home to western low-land gorillas and orangutans.



Following lunch on the National Mall we'll take a short walk to the **National Museum of Natural History** for "a rare encounter" where you'll catch a glimpse of the Wittelsbach-Graf Diamond weighing in at 31.06 carats. We'll visit Deeper than Light, a traveling exhibit that follows a scientist's journey into the deep sea. Be sure to check out the new exhibit in the David H. Koch Hall that follows the story of human evolution. That evening we'll head back to the hotel for dinner and our DSI Seniors Tribute.

On Sunday, April 18, 2010 we'll head back to the National Mall to visit the **National Museum of American History** to discover the history of science, technology, society and culture in America.
